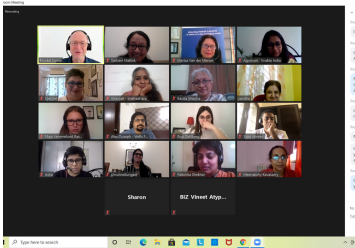
PRAGATI SHOWCASES SKILLS at ISRAEL INDEPENDENCE DAY

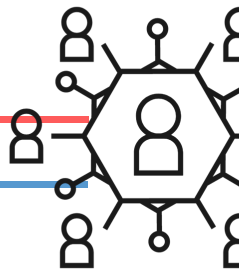


PREVENTIVE and AWARENESS WORKSHOP with PARENTS on COVID 19

Three month paid internship at Thomson Reuters for Persons With Disabilities

We are glad to inform that two young adults from Biswa Gouri Charitable Trust got selected for Thomson Reuters paid internship for three months. We were given the opportunity through the Mission1000 project of Enable India and DNA. This is one of the first initiatives in India, to provide workability-based experience to PWDs through different departments of Thomson Reuters.

Our students underwent one-month rigorous employability training to upgrade the skills needed to adapt to the fast-paced work environment and timings. The employability training addressed the various requirements of the wholesome experience of being on a job role. The trainers under employability training eventually faded out with the reduction in hours spent with the interns in weekly basis.

The interns have been recruited in various departments of Thomson Reuters. We are proud to see their potential and capacities growing in their assigned roles.

We wish to achieve our mission and vision through the collective and combined efforts of all. We are thankful to Enable India & DNA for being the pillars of Mission1000 project and providing the opportunities to young adults with Autism and Intellectual Disabilities to reach their true potential. LEADERSHIP PARTICIPATION in SEVERAL EVENTS

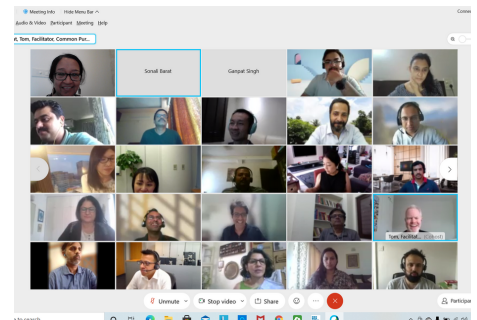
Ms Sarbani Mallick, our founder director, was invited to join **Common Purpose** as an Advisor as part of the "Barclays Making it Real" workshop.
